Heifer Project: On Sunday, February 17th, we will pass out the Heifer Project banks. This is our Lenten mission project. We encourage everyone to participate. Last year we raised \$3,213.90 with which we purchased 2 flocks of

geese; 2 flocks of chicks; 2 heifers; 1 camel; 1 water buffalo; 2 llamas; 2 goats; 2 sheep; 1 group of tree seedlings; 1 trio of rabbits; and 4 honey bee hives. Since we started participating in this program in 2003, we've raised \$14,024.04 for this important ministry. Wow!

Heifer Project Reading Program: We will be adding some new books to the United Methodist's Women's bookshelf in the Sunday School hallway. We hope all our youth will find a book and learn more about farming, where our food comes from, and how we can all be better stewards of God's good creation.

Lenten Bible Study: On the Road with Jesus: Birth and Ministry:

Travel to the Holy Land with New Testament scholar Ben Witherington and experience the birth and ministry of Jesus in this **four-session video study**.
